Program Expectations and Parental Permission Online Study Skills Course

The Program has established standards of conduct for all Participants. It is the responsibility of the Parent/Legal Guardian and the Participant to review the Program rules and standards of conduct. Dismissed Participants may not be eligible for a refund of any fees or expenses.

The Program agrees to:

- 1. Provide information outlining the activities of the Program including the times, days, and how to access content.
- 2. Collect registration information such as participant name, address, phone number, parents/guardian(s) name(s), phone number(s) and email(s).
- 3. Provide a supply list and recommendations for setting up the home work space to help participants fully engage in the program.
- 4. Only allow registered participants to participate.
- 5. Only communicate with participants through official Program platforms.
- 6. Keep conversations and interactions focused on the Program goals and objectives.
- 7. Create an environment where everyone is welcomed and given the opportunity to succeed.
- 8. Address problems that are brought to their attention.
- 9. Will not share personal information, email, or social media accounts with minor participants.

The Participant agrees to:

- 1. Not share links or passwords for Program meetings or content.
- 2. Challenge themselves to engage, be present and learn.
- 3. Complete assigned activities.
- 4. Request help if needed.
- 5. Not take inappropriate screenshots or images.
- 6. Assume good intentions and have fun!

The Parent/Legal Guardian(s) agrees to:

- 1. Assist the participant in setting up the home environment to meet the goals of the Program.
- 2. Ensure the participant is prepared for the Program.
- 3. Limit distractions and keep the participant safe throughout the duration of the Program.
- 4. Allow time for the participant to complete assignments.
- 5. Communicate with staff if the participant is not able to participate
- 6. Work with Program staff to resolve issues that may arise.

The following may result in being dismissed from the program:

Violation of a University code, policy, or regulation.

What are the consequences if the participant does not meet Program expectations?

- 1. Staff will give a verbal or written warning regarding behaviors and actions that are not allowed and in most cases give the participant an opportunity to correct the behavior.
- 2. Depending on the behavior, they may also contact the parent or legal guardian.
- 3. In some cases, staff may require a corrective action plan in order to stay in the program.
- 4. Some behaviors may result in immediate suspension or termination.
